

Anglia Square was never completed. Additional phases were planned but were not built.

One phase would have seen shops placed on the southern end of the upper deck and a restaurant on the north side.

Diners would have been able to look out over the square.

Sovereign House was to be extended to
Pitt Street under another phase with a
pedestrian footway linking the Square
to St Augustine's Street. Land for these
additional phases was compulsorily
purchased and buildings demolished.
These empty areas are now used as
surface car parks.
